This key leadership role will oversee the mining operation and associated infrastructure to efficiently and safely extract ore and recover heavy mineral concentrate (HMC) suitable for direct sales and/or deliver to the downstream mineral separation plant (MSP).

Key responsibilities include:

- Provide senior site-based leadership and management of the integrated dry-mining operations and wet concentration plant to achieve performance objectives
- Develop and implement the operational plans, systems, processes and procedures to deliver day-to-day mining activities in accordance with the strategic plan and KPIs
- KPI's include safety, environmental compliance, sustainability, production and commercial performance, people management, team development and governance
- Plan and optimise mining and processing methods, grade control, plant and equipment utilisation, operational and maintenance strategies to drive efficiencies and high performance
