Strandline is now seeking an experienced Manager **Asset and Engineering** to join our operations readiness team and transition into operations. Reporting to the General Manager Operations the purpose of this senior management role is to lead the site asset management and maintenance activities ensuring that our asset health is maintained and continuously improved. This leadership role will oversee the maintenance teams across the mine facilities, wet concentration plant and mineral separation plant ensuring the Health and Safety of employees and contractors are maintained. This role will initially be Perth based for the next 6 months then site based.

To be considered you will need to demonstrate strong experience in project and operations planning, preparing and implementing effective asset management, maintenance and reliability strategies for all assets.

Key responsibilities include:

Manage the development and implementation of the maintenance management strategies, systems and processes.

Introduce and imbed appropriate maintenance standards including root cause problem solving and reliability based engineered solutions.

Manage the development of supply chains and life cycle plans for all equipment with correct budgeting for midlife rebuilds and end of life replacement.

Ensure all projects are executed in accordance with Strandline's project and operations management standards. Standardise equipment and processes and manage the implementation sustaining capital works for the site in consultation with stakeholders.

Plan and manage overall execution of operations ensuring synergies between people, processes, and strategies to implement actions to deliver on business objectives.

Manage the financial performance of allocated department or business area to achieve or exceed agreed targets. Implement initiative to improve cost effectiveness and risk mitigation.

Fostering a culture of continuous improvement and innovation including cost reduction initiatives; making sure best practice process is in place across each functional area

Provide leadership in shaping and modelling desired behaviours within the team.
